Guest Speaker: Teus Kappers

Teus and Maria met while they were students in the Bible Collage of Wales, Swansea U.K. It was there during their student years from 1970-1972, that Teus visited his first ship from the then USSR. Teus and Maria were married in 1972 and in 1973 they were invited by the London City Mission to run a seamen ministry in Tilbury docks. Reluctantly they accepted, as Tilbury was hard dockland and not a good place to bring up children. As it turned out Tilbury became a place of great spiritual blessing and many seafarers became followers of Jesus. Also, Tilbury became a very good training ground for future ministry. In 1982 the Kappers family, now five in number, came by invitation to Vancouver, to start a new ministry to seafarers called “Lighthouse Harbour Ministries”. The Lord has greatly blessed the ministry as they have expanded the work to the ports of Nanaimo, Prince Rupert and Victoria with new ministries starting on Canada’s East Coast. The Kappers have three children and five grandchildren.

Valerie Ransom, is a mother to her son, Jakob and is a wife to Keith Ransom. She has been involved in music and worship at First Baptist Church, Nanaimo from a young age and is currently Music Director. She has produced several CD’s including, The Light, and By Faith.
