





These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, in order that you may **know** that you have eternal life" (1 John 5:11–13).

Thank God often that Christ is in your life. He will never leave you (*Hebrews 13:5*).

You can know that Christ lives in you and that you have eternal life because of His promise.
